FROM THE MC

The recently completed hydrologist's "preliminary modeling report" is available in the library. Please leave the report in the library and let Mary know if you would like a printed copy.

The detailed model shows the sources of water that feed into the lakes, the capacity of each pond and lake for storing water, the level where water drains from Lower Lake to Camp Evers Creek, and most importantly, what and where the flooding potential is. Maps show the potential flooding extent and depth for intense 24-hour storms using models for what are termed 10-year, 25-year, and 100-year storms. Perusing this report will give you important context for the forthcoming recommendations that partners will have the final vote on.


These risk levels aid decisions such as whether and where to excavate or fill depressions, and to confine or release drainage water. The final stage in the hydrologist's project began this week, to identify constraints and opportunities for our lakes' system, and for the Upper Commons planning.

Entering the bird migration season, the possibility increases that birds infected with bird flu would enter the park. In wild birds, the flu mainly affects waterfowl, and some may carry it without showing symptoms. If you find a dead bird, please keep your distance, and alert the maintenance crew, who follow health guidelines when disposing of it.
