## From the Management Committee

A lot of big projects are underway in our park these days. The MC is making every effort to keep the partners informed at our general meetings on the 4th Tuesday of each month, but we understand that not all partners are able to attend, nor do we always know what may be of interest to all partners.

Our staff has been doing an excellent job of managing many of these projects in-house to help keep our costs down. However, they have also been subjected to many daily interruptions with questions, often the same question, from different partners while performing their duties. Staff includes the park manager, maintenance supervisor and employees, the office manager, and all the assistant managers. Each of these employees is paid by us by the hour, so constant interruptions and your questions/suggestions while they are working is costing all of us real dollars.

Ultimately, the management committee is responsible for making decisions for the smooth operation of this park. Here are the most effective ways to bring our attention to your questions and concerns.

1. File a blue sheet. These are available in the office and will go directly to the management committee for consideration at their next team meeting.  
**NOTE:** Do not give any requests to any single member of the staff. The committee has a process to follow so this is the most secure way of having your request or comments heard/acted upon.
2. Email the MC Chair (Tim Willoughby at [redmtn2@comcast.net](mailto:redmtn2@comcast.net)). He will take your questions/concerns to the next team meeting.
3. Attend the MC meetings on the fourth Tuesday of the month and raise your question there.

4. Volunteer for the MC! We still have room for another volunteer on the committee.
