NOTICE TO ALL RESIDENTS:

Per Spring Lakes Park Rules & Regulations regarding guest parking!

B. Parking

1. Due to the width of our streets (sixteen (16) feet to thirty-one (31) feet), no street parking is permitted day or night per Title 25 of the California Code of Regulations*. Stopping temporarily in front of Resident's home is permitted for loading/unloading (after which the vehicle should be moved to an appropriate parking space). Exception: Parking may be allowed on the street at the Clubhouse and Party House during special events and during private resident's events.
2. **Residents may use the visitor parking areas when their driveways are being used by a contractor or visitor. Otherwise, residents are not permitted to park in Visitor Parking Areas.**
3. Care-Givers (Home Health Aids, Visiting Nurses, Physical Therapists, and Daily Care Givers) are required to park either in the resident's carport or in Visitor Parking Areas. Care-Givers can only park in front of a resident's home temporarily for the purpose of loading or unloading.
4. **Full-Time, Live-in Caregiver's vehicles are considered the same as resident's vehicles, must be parked in the resident's carport and abide by all "Use of Roads and Vehicles" rules.**
5. Construction/Service vehicles are allowed to park on the street in front of a home while working on repairs or performing service. Work hours are 8:00 am until 5:00 pm.

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE: Per Rule #42

Dear Residents, Please be advised that as a matter of Policy in the Spring Lakes Park rules (Rule 42) it is the responsibility of each resident to maintain lawns, flowers, shrubs and other landscaping at all times. This includes trees as well as larger growing shrubs. Thank you for your attention to this detail. Park Management

Junipers, Friend or Foe?

Not only do Junipers offer an ideal nesting area for rodents, they also pose a fire hazard. Several varieties of Juniper contain highly flammable resins, they can accumulate dead leaves and needles and as they age, they become more prone to easily ignite. The park will begin the removal of all Junipers in the common areas and replace them with drought tolerant and fire resistant plants and shrubs such as: Lantana, Bee Blossom, and Penstemon. The Management Committee recommends partners who have Junipers in their yards as landscaping consider removal and replacement. 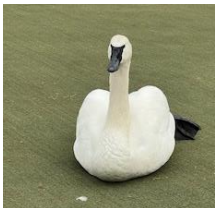
