SUMMER BIRD REPORT



Bird numbers were a bit down these last few months due to several factors: No water in Upper Lake or Pond, major work removing plants along the Lower Lake, birds are much quieter (and harder to find/identify) once breeding season is over. Anyway, here are the number of species seen in our park for June (42), July (45) and August (41).

This is just a partial list of some of the birds seen in the park recently: Hermit Thrush, Great Horned Owl (heard), Black-headed Grosbeak, Killdeer, Double-crested Cormorant, Hooded Oriole, Orange-crowned

Warbler, Brown-headed Cowbird, Brewer's Blackbird, Black-crowned Night Heron, Green Heron, Western Flycatcher, Purple Finch, Warbling Vireo, Cooper's Hawk, Belted Kingfisher, Great Egret, and Western Tanager. Submitted by June Langhoff
