- Bank Accounts balances – Total: **\$799,141.14**
- The Infrastructure Account balance is lower because the MC approved moving \$200,000 from Santa Cruz Couty Bank into the Morgan Stanley account to accrue a higher interest rate.
- Budget Performance Q1. Q2. And Q3 = as of 9/25/2024: Total positive budget performance = \$20,385.
- Eleven homes have been sold since January 2024.
- Extra Chapin Loan Payment – Paid \$30,000 to be applied to principle only on September 15, 2024.
- Total Extra Chapin Loan Payment - \$89,500 loan to date.
